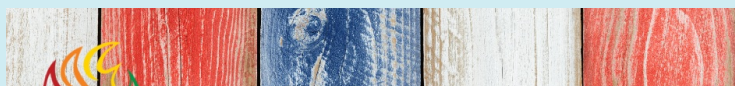

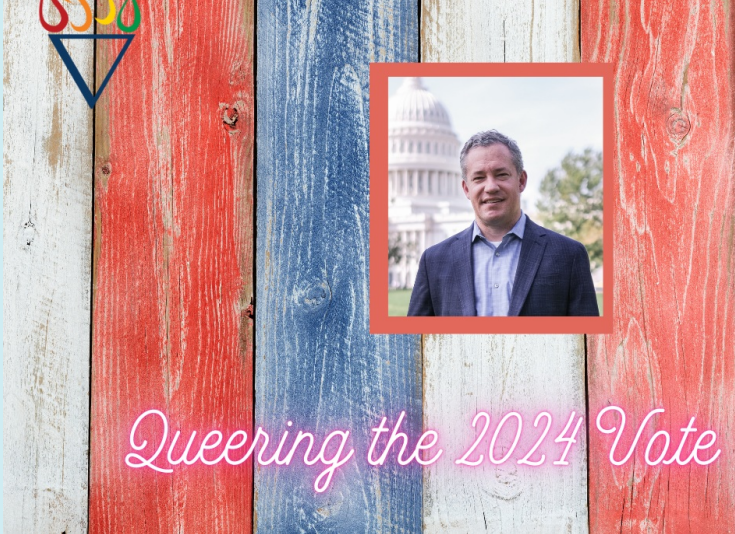

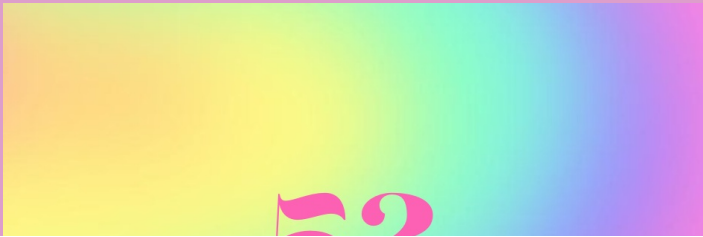


The CLGS Archives Project

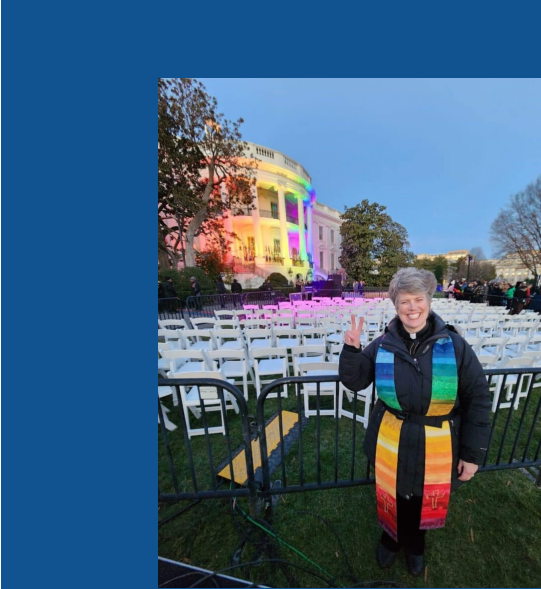
Mi Dor L’Dor: Queer Jews Across The Generations

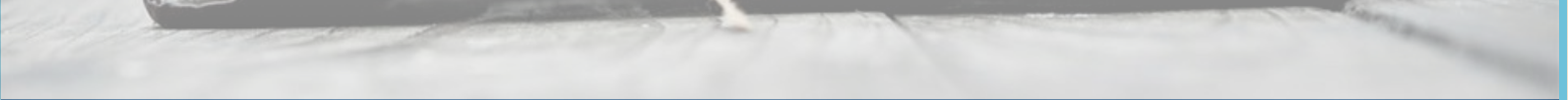
