




Our Trans Religious Leadership Cohort Class of 2025-2026

CLGS is a proud co-sponsor of the **Trans Religious Leadership Cohort**, which is a collaborative partnership between CLGS, the Freedom Center for Social Justice, and the National LGBTQ Task Force.

This month we celebrate Pastor **Corii Gino Varner**, a black, transmasculine, male-centered, Spirit-filled individual. After serving 8 years in the Air Force and working in computer technology, Corii moved to Minnesota in 1994, becoming involved with the LGBTQ community.

Corii began their ministry journey as a Deacon in 2002, becoming an ordained Reverend in 2008. They currently pastor Nu Generation Gathering in Minnesota and are members of TFAM. Pastor Varner earned an MDiv degree in 2017 in Social Justice/Reconciliation and Pastoral Care/Counseling, and is currently pursuing a DMin degree. Corii cares for family, enjoys kids, dogs, basketball, bowling, billiards, and music.


